Dance Pictures

Dance Pictures are the week of April 13 – 16 at Footworks Dance Company. Debbie Daanen Photography will be taking pictures. No regular classes will be held this week. No food or drink at the studio this week with costumes. Please arrive 10 minutes ahead of your picture time. Parents are not allowed in the photography rooms. We take group photos this week, therefore we encourage full attendance. If you have only 1 costume, please arrive in your costume. Dance Rehearsal Expectations

- Every dancer at Footworks has to attend a mandatory dress rehearsal in order to perform in the recital. This helps each dancer and parent understand structure of the show and prepare for performing. Mandatory dress rehearsals will be held on TUESDAY, MAY 12TH and THURSDAY, MAY 14TH at Kaukauna High School from 4:15 pm to 9:30 pm. Your child will receive a detailed rehearsal schedule as the date get closer which will narrow your times down.
- Please drop off your child on time! We will not be able to wait on dancers who are late, as we need to run on time, to stay on schedule. Dancers should check in with the auditorium attendant and a Footworks helper will assist them to the auditorium seating area. Dancers will sit in a row with their classmates.
- Please look carefully at your rehearsal schedule for all your appropriate times. Your child should arrive in costume, with hair neatly secured up, and make-up complete.
- **PARENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE AUDIENCE DURING REHEARSALS, but parents can remain at the school in the commons/lobby area.**
- Dancers will be brought out to the lobby as soon as they are finished performing their last routine in their allotted time block. Many dancers have multiple allotted time blocks. They are allowed to go home when they are done rehearsing.
- Children will be FULLY supervised in the auditorium area for the entire duration of the rehearsal and recital. Volunteers will stay with each class during the rehearsal and the recital and remain with the class until every child is picked up on both days. Your child's safety is very important to us. **Please help keep all our students safe by respecting and following these rules.**

If you have any further questions regarding dress rehearsals, please contact the studio before rehearsal/recital events. The rehearsal schedule will be available soon. Thank you!

Recital Information

- The recitals are Saturday, May 16th. There are 2 shows scheduled at Kaukauna High School. Our first show (SHOW A) will start at 12:30 pm for Shooting Stars & Competition Co Dancers. Our 2nd show (SHOW B) will start at 3:30 pm for Enrichment Academy and Competition Co Dancers.
- Dancers will need to be in their dressing room, ready to dance with their hair and make-up completed approximately 30 minutes prior to show time. Please allow extra time to arrive at the school. Costume, hair and make-up often take longer than expected. If your child is rushed or late, this may cause them to be frazzled on stage and unable to perform their best.
- Please remain seated during the performance as much as possible. If you have a young child or need to get up for health reasons, please try to purchase tickets at the end of an aisle.
- Auditorium doors will open at **12 pm and 3 pm for seating.**
- For the safety of our dancers, and enjoyment of those seated around you, flash photography is strictly prohibited during the performance.
- During the recital, please remember that there is no coming and going. **No dancers will be released at intermission or at any other time throughout the recital.** Immediately following the show, send one guardian to pick your dancer up in their dressing room.
- Finally, we invite you to slow down and enjoy the day with your family. A dancer's participation in the show is much more than the time spent on stage. It is a whole experience, an opportunity to share something with loved ones and a chance to celebrate a huge accomplishment. It is a time spent with dance friends making wonderful memories.

Backstage Etiquette and Tips

- SEND A DRY SNACK AND WATER WITH YOUR CHILD TO THE RECITAL.
- PLEASE SEND YOUR CHILD WITH A SMALL BAG CONTAINING BOOKS, COLORING OR AN ACTIVITY. THIS IS EXTREMELY HELPFUL FOR OUR YOUNGER DANCERS. FOOTWORKS WILL ALSO PROVIDE COLORING OPTIONS AT THE SHOW.
- PLEASE BE SURE TO SEND A NOTE WITH YOUR CHILD CONCERNING ANY ALLERGIES OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS HE/SHE MAY HAVE.
- DANCERS' NAMES SHOULD BE ON ALL THEIR BELONGINGS AND SENT IN A BAG. DANCERS SHOULD HAVE ALL COSTUMES, HEADPIECES AND SHOES WITH THEM FOR THE REHEARSAL AND RECITAL.
- FOOTWORKS IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ITEMS LEFT AT KAUKAUNA HIGH SCHOOL. ANY ITEMS THAT ARE LEFT IN THE DRESSING ROOMS WILL BE DISCARDED FOLLOWING THE REHEARSAL OR SHOW.
- DANCERS ARE EXPECTED TO REMAIN IN THEIR DRESSING ROOM DURING THE DURATION OF THE RECITAL (INCLUDING INTERMISSION). DURING THE REHEARSAL THEY WILL BE EXPECTED TO REMAIN IN THE DESIGNATED SEATING AREA WHEN NOT PERFORMING. PLEASE EAT BEFORE THE SHOW.
- NO BRIGHT NAIL POLISH, JEWELRY OR ACCESSORIES THAT ARE NOT PART OF THE COSTUME SHOULD BE WORN AT REHEARSAL OR RECITAL.
- PLEASE AVOID UNDERWEAR UNDER TIGHTS/COSTUMES, AS IT CREATES LINES AND BUMPS AND CAN BE VISIBLE UNDER THE LIGHTS. SPECIAL NUDE UNDERGARMENTS CAN BE ORDERED ONLINE. PLEASE SEE THE FRONT DESK IF THIS IS OF INTEREST TO YOU.
- THE SHOWS ARE APPROXIMATELY 2.5 HOURS

Costumes, Hair and Make-up

Our website, www.footworksdancecompy.com, will offer specific requirements for shoes and tights, along with more detailed information. Use the “recital” tab.

Costumes should never be ironed, as the heat is too much for the sensitive fabrics. Instead, use a steamer, or hang the costume upside down on a hanger and place it in the bathroom when taking a hot shower. When storing tutus, upside down on a hanger is a great way to keep them full. Remember to keep your costumes in a safe place. Costumes cannot be replaced if lost or damaged. Costumes should only be worn for pictures, performances, and the recital. Keep this in mind when ordering your size in the fall, as well.

All dancers, regardless of age, will need light make-up and lipstick. We suggest foundation, blush, lipstick, and neutral tone eyeshadows (such as tans/browns). The stage lights are very bright, and dancers will appear “washed out” without make-up. Your teacher will let you know how to wear any accessories.

Dancers will need to check their shoes and tights chart (available in emails and on the website). Many classes need tights (BALERA OR WEISSMANS brand tights is required) and most classes need specific shoes. A listing of tights, shoes and accessories for each class can be found on our website:

ALL dancers will need to have their hair in some sort of “up do”. A low pony with bangs secured back, is a great option for all dance genres. A bun is a great choice for ballet dancers.

Dancers may want to bring a bathrobe or zip/button cover-up to wear while waiting to perform.

If you have costume changes, we strongly recommend nude undergarments or leotards to be worn under the costume. No colored undergarments are to be worn under costumes.

Volunteers

Limited volunteer opportunities are available at our recital. For inquiries on volunteering or to volunteer, please stop by our front desk. For volunteer responsibilities, please go to our website at www.footworksdancecompany.com and click on “recital” tab. Parents can watch their dancer perform from backstage. The recital is also streamed in the dressing rooms. To register to volunteer, please see Ms Terri or Ms Allyssa at the front desk. Availability is limited. **If you have a dancer who is still in a diaper or pull-up, it is required that one parent volunteer.** Due to the overwhelming female dancers backstage, volunteering is limited to females in our dressing rooms. We have opportunities for dads/male volunteers outside of the dressing rooms by inquiring at the desk.

Recital Tickets

All seats are reserved. You can purchase tickets for Footworks “LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION” at Tutu Tix. Any remaining seats will be available at the door the evening of the show. We recommend ordering tickets early, as space is limited. A link to Tutu Tix is available on our website. **Tickets will go on sale April 15 at 9 am.** <https://tututix.com>. 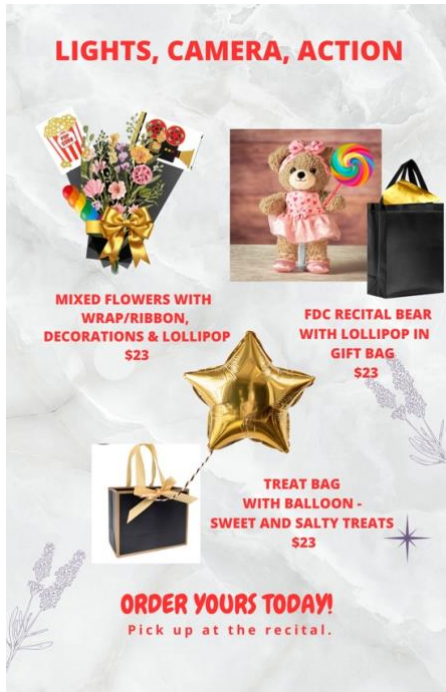
